










## Lifesize Vocabulary Guide

<p><b>Lifesize Icon</b> is a hardware-based video conference system.</p>	<p><b>Lifesize Cloud</b> is an online service that includes bridging, firewall traversal, directory, recording, streaming, and more.</p> 
<p><b>Lifesize Phone</b> is part of the Lifesize Icon system and includes microphone, speakers and controls.</p>	<p><b>Contacts</b> – A List of all registered users within the Lifesize Cloud account. This list does not include guests.</p> 
<p><b>Room Systems</b> – Lifesize Icons that are physically located in a room or office and registered to Lifesize Cloud.</p> 	<p><b>Meetings</b> - Virtual meeting rooms (VMRs) within Lifesize Cloud are where participants can easily join from desktops, web browsers, mobile devices, or room systems.</p> 
<p><b>Calls</b> connect to meetings (virtual meeting rooms) using video and voice, voice, or audio only.</p> 	<p><b>Join by Phone</b> - Connect from a cell phone or landline.</p> <p>Call in by phone          US: +1-844-572-5683 extension <span style="border: 1px solid red; padding: 2px;">123456</span></p>
<p> <b>Start with Camera On</b></p> <p>Connect to a call from video enabled devices and systems with video AND voice.</p>	<p> <b>Start with Camera Off</b></p> <p>Connect from video enabled devices and systems with voice ONLY.</p>
<p><b>Share Your Screen</b> – This is how to present content that is on your computer with the other site(s).</p> 	<p><b>Pip</b> is short for picture in picture which also means local video.</p> 
<p><b>Guests</b> are anyone connecting to a call that is not a registered user in the Lifesize Cloud account. Guests can share their screen, but cannot begin a recording.</p>	<p><b>Meeting ID</b> (Extension or Dial String) is the specific number assigned to a virtual meeting room, room system or user in the Lifesize Cloud service.</p>
